The Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) is changing its approach to ordering FTS2001 for its customers as a result of AT&T becoming an FTS2001 provider.

Previously, DISA selected Sprint to provide frame relay and packet switched services, WCOM (formerly MCI) to provide switched voice services, and Sprint and WCOM to compete for private line services. To ensure that a true partnership exists with all FTS2001 providers, we now will grant all partners equal provider status. As of 1 January 2003, DISA's customers will be allowed to use Sprint, WCOM, or AT&T to meet their FTS2001 telecommunications needs as they deem necessary.
